• Course description:

The European internal market is the most advanced element in the European geo-regional supranational integration. It has been successful for a long time and can serve as a model for economic integration in other parts of the world. The law of the European internal market is part of European Union law, since the European Union represents not only the institutional framework but as well the location for the substantive law of the European integration. The course provides a short introduction into European Union law and then deals with EU internal market law, in particular with the economic fundamental freedoms of the citizens of the Union (free movement of goods, freedom of movement for workers, freedom of establishment, freedom to provide services, freedom of the movement of capital and of payments). These economic freedoms have a great impact on the daily life in the European Union but are also important for non-European companies that are active in the European market, in particular through own subsidiaries. Many concepts and ideas developed in this field may inspire the development of international business law in other parts of the world. The course will present the general theory and the specific features of the fundamental freedoms. It will also deal with the approximation of laws in the internal market and the competition law of the European Union, two elements that have proved to be essential for the realization and safeguard of the internal market.

The course is not limited to a theoretical presentation but also introduces briefly to the *techniques of case-solving* in the field of European internal market law. The participants will study how to approach a concrete case, work out the exact question of the case and structure and formulate the case solution. Two case studies will deal with the economic fundamental freedoms.

• Conditions:

The course will be held in English. It is open to students of the 3rd and 4th grade, postgraduate students and students of Foreign Trade University. Participants who attend at least 14 of the 20 lectures will receive a certificate of participation.
